

I am sitting in my sister's kitchen in Exmouth, a beautiful little beach town right on the Ningaloo Reef in Western Australia. It has been over 15 years since I have wriggled my toes in the warm West Australian and floated in the Indian Ocean. Everything is as beautiful, raw and wonderful as I remember and I am already preparing myself for tears as I drive away from the red earth and back home to lush Fish Creek.

We will have spent most of this month in our swags, as close that red sand as we can be. My children are tinged pink and they always have dusty salt on their skin.

We just spent the last 4 days in Karijini National Park. The hikes in this park expect one to be sure footed and brave. Our kids skirted the edges of the gorges, climbed down cliffs into crystal clear waterholes, stood still with arms crossed when met with dingoes, watched a brown snake find a safe rock and quietly visited a sacred waterhole.

I had many moments where I have had to stop myself from yelling out 'BE CAREFUL', I had to trust my daughters, trust their feet, trust the rocks and trust their swimming skills as they swam through the gorges. They had to remember their hats, their water and to apply sunscreen. They had to treat the outdoors with respect and love.

Karijini reminded me what a wonderful teacher nature is for both my children and us, the parents.

I hope these holidays found you somewhere in nature with the people you love.
