A message from the Principal

Today will be our final newsletter for the term as next week we have an extremely busy week with our Grade 5/6 students away at Mount Bulla on Snow Camp and our Grade 3/4 students at Phillip Island. 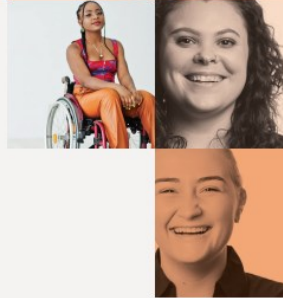


Good Bye
